# MPTC in Brief (Con)

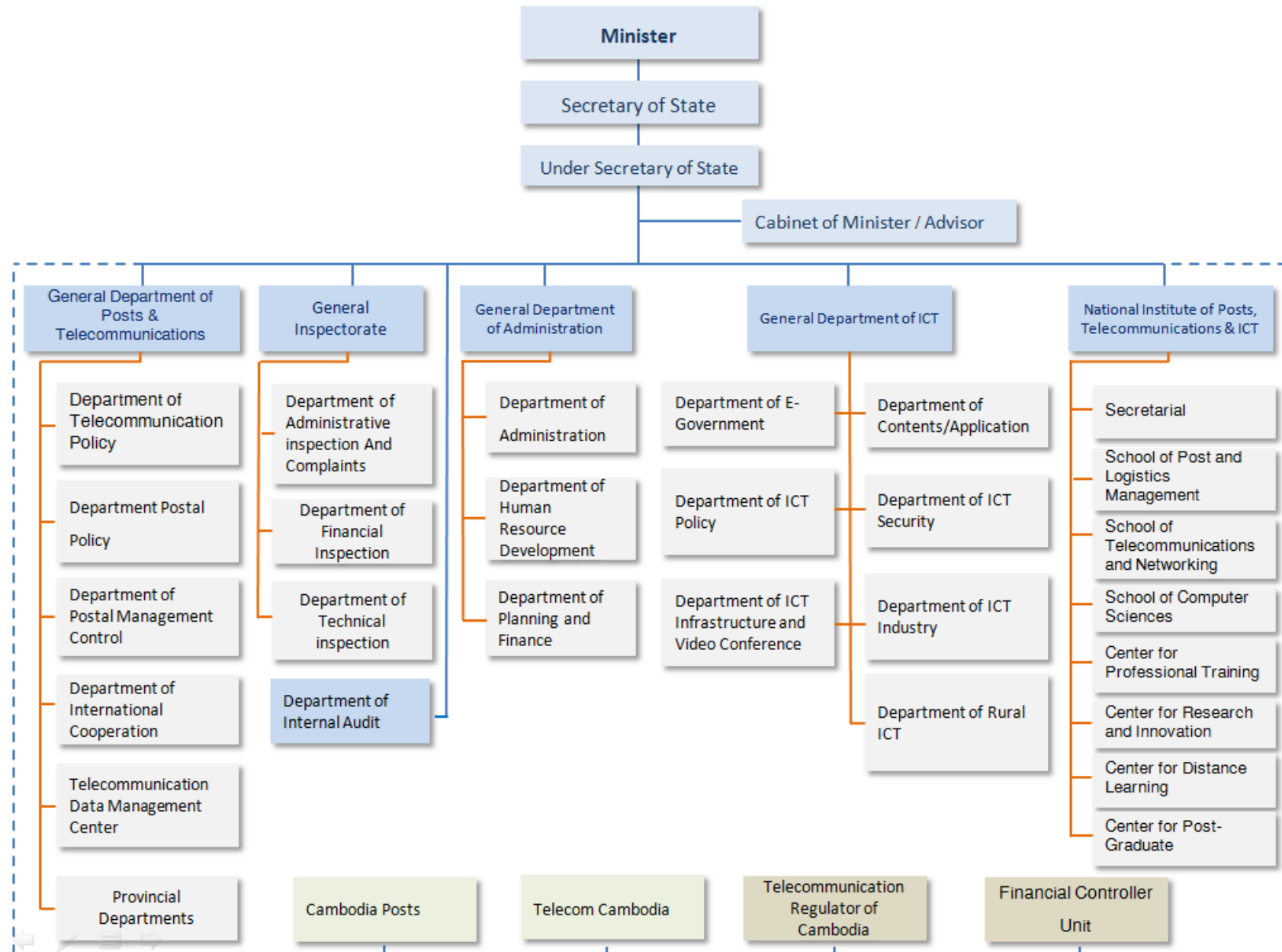
## MISSION

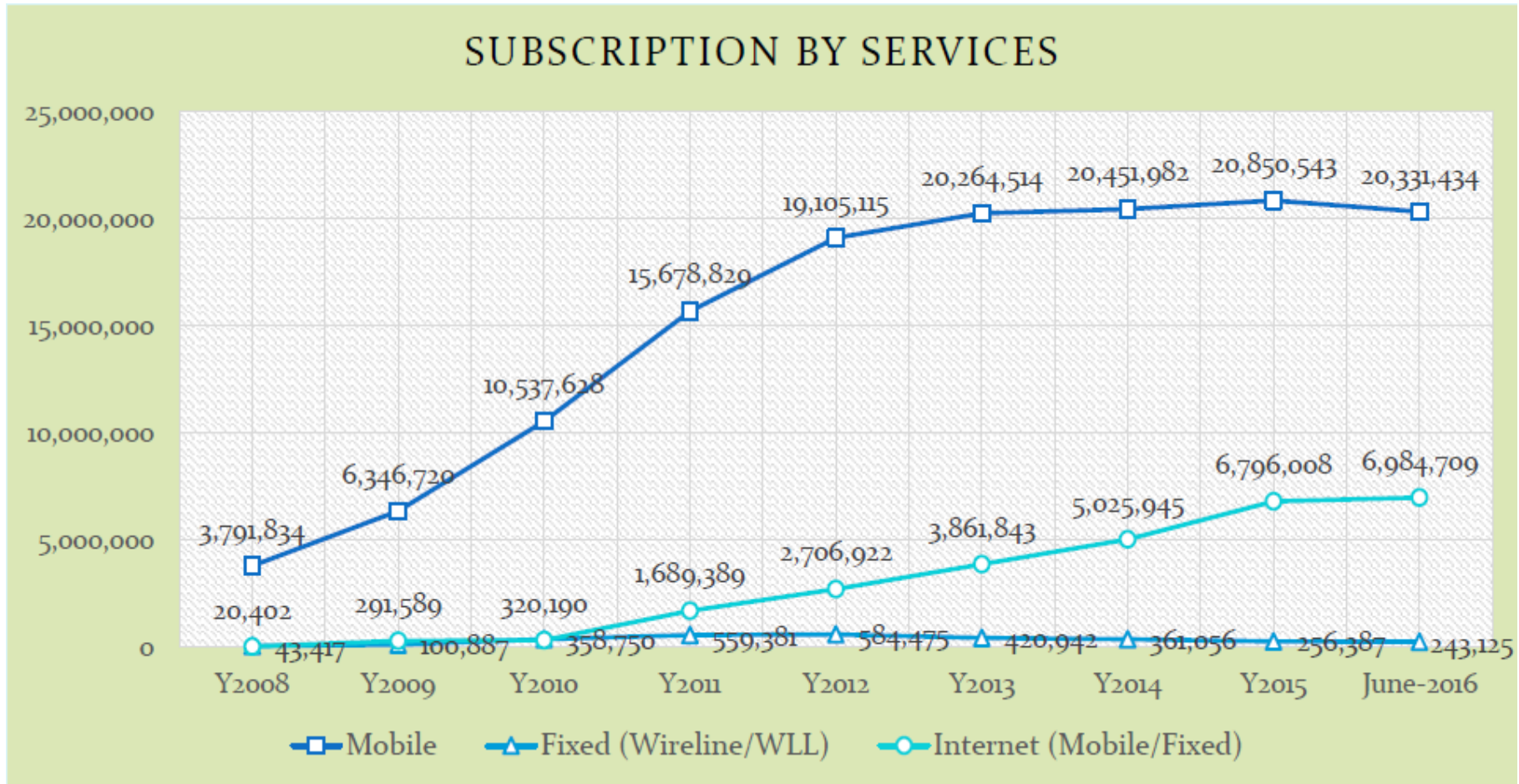

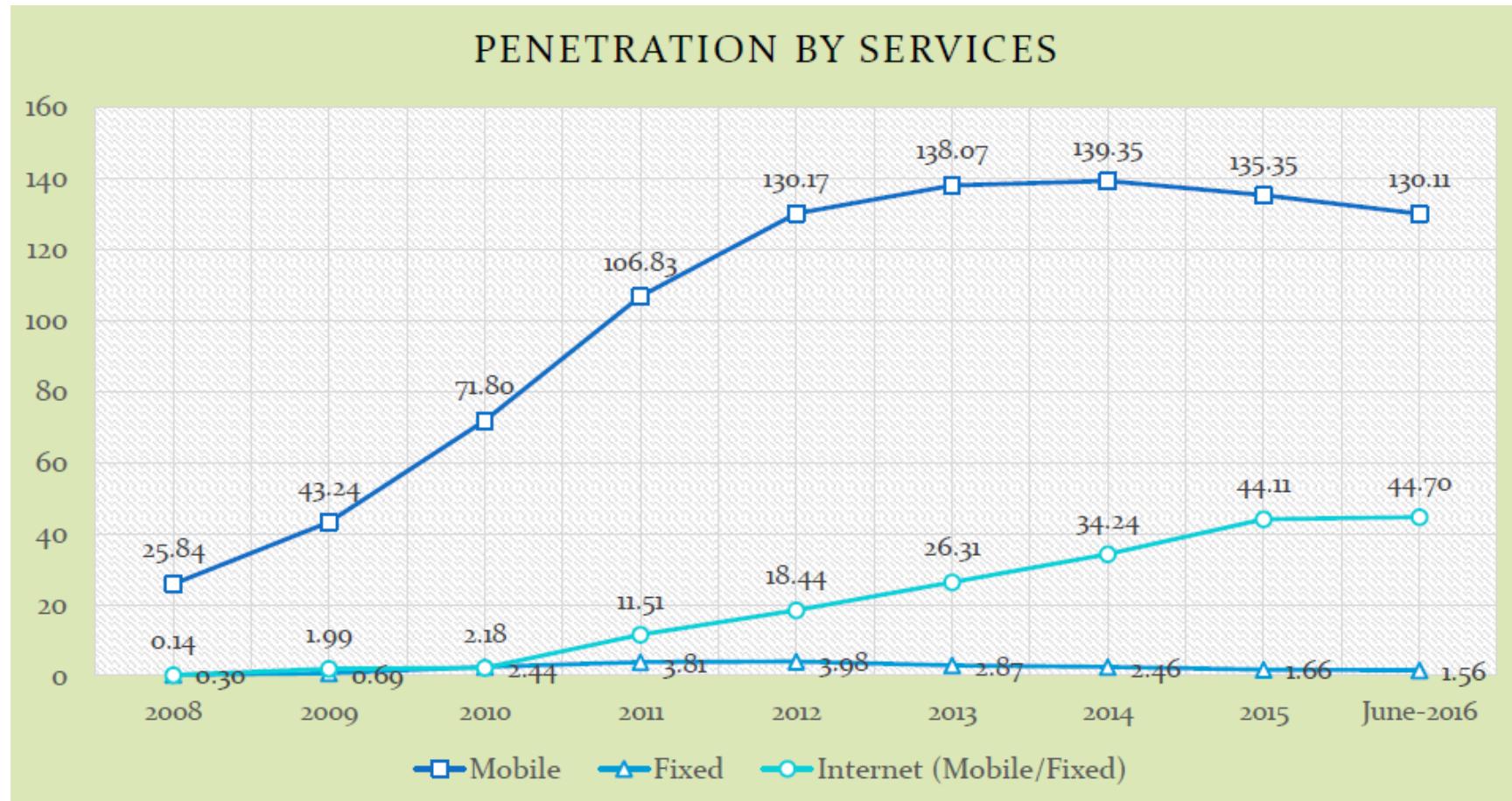
